Button, Button, Who's Got the Button?



This is a guessing game played in a circle.

You need a button.

In our country, we play it with a ring.

This game is best played with at least six players.

Choose someone to be "**It**" and give the button or the ring to him or her. The rest of the players stand in a circle with their hands in front of them, palms together.

"It" holds his or her hands the same way with the button or ring hidden in between them and goes around the circle to each player."It" passes his or her hands downward between those of each other player, not letting the others know whether he has left the button/ring in their hands or not, but leaves the button/ring with one of them.

After "It" has been around to all the players, he or she asks, "Button, button, who's got the button?"

or "Ring,ring,who's got the ring?,and sings four times:

"A ring is lost four times I'll tell you If the owner is not here the ring will be for me"



Each player makes a guess until the one who has the button is found. The one who makes the right guess gets to be "**It**" the next time around.
