

## Flowers, Animals or Movies

The game is called "Flowers, Animals or Movies".

It is fun and children learn from each other. It is all about guessing a flower, an animal or a movie, based on a hint.

To play the game you need five to seven players, a bench or a bigger place to sit and a place of about 15 square meters. It can be played both indoors and outdoors.

Here are the rules:

1. Two children are chosen to team up.
2. The other children sit on the bench.
3. The selected team chooses a flower, animal or movie to be guessed by the others and agree on the hint to be given. (For example, if they choose "rabbit" the hint could be "It is small with long ears")
4. The children sitting down ask: "Flowers, animals or movies?" The selected team answers the question (in our example: "Animal") and gives the hint.
- 5 One by one, the children on the bench try to guess by naming a flower, animal or movie (as the case may be).
6. The child who guesses correctly will replace the oldest member of the selected team while the replaced child takes a seat on the bench.
7. The game goes on from step 1.



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
