Lesson Objectives: 1. To practice and understand the structure in English language.

- **5.** To encourage the feeling of good independence and get self-confidence

Assumptions: the students are going to be familiar with the structure in a correct sentence or question in English.

**Aim: to practice English** 

Materials: none, just themselves

two scarves

# The lesson.

### How do I look?

#### 1

Two students - with scarves for their eyes/blindfolded are going to tell the rest of the class how the other one is wearing and color, the hair color and the eye color.

The two students have to say a sentence. They get one point for every right answer.

The one with most points after ten sentences is the winner.

Let a new pair try.

## 2

One student has to leave the classroom for three minutes.

During this time the rest of the class agree on - which other student they are going to have in their mind – but not to tell.

The student comes back into the classroom again, and starts asking questions.

- has he or she long hair
- has he or she short hair
- has he or she yellow jeans

And so on – until he/she can name the student the class picked out.

#### 3

Another way of doing this is – working in pair or a small group.

The students have a girl or a boy in their mind, describe he/she without telling the name. Let the other guess.
