Lesson Objectives: 1. To learn something about English culture
2. To understand and use a recipe in English
3. To lay a table
4. To learn conversation and good behavior during a meal

## 5. To encourage cooperation

Assumptions:
The pupils are used to work in a kitchen and understand a recipe.

Anticipated problems:
Some words and expressions in the recipe might be unknown.

Materials:
Equipment and ingredients for the baking.
English dictionary.
Computer

Activity 1: To bake scones
Aim:
To learn something about English culture.
To understand and use a recipe in English.
To encourage cooperation.

## Procedure:

The pupils are divided in groups of 3-4. Each group makes a portion of the recipe.

Here is the recipe:
SCONES (12 pieces):

## 225 g flour

2 teaspoons baking powder
60 g butter or margarine
30 g sugar
$1,5 \mathrm{dl}$ milk
raisins
milk for glazing

Preheat oven to $\mathbf{2 2 0}$ grades $\mathbf{C}$ and lightly grease a large baking sheet.
Shift the flour and add the sugar.
Rub in the butter until mixture looks like fine breadcrumbs.
Add the raisins, and then add the milk to make a soft dough.
Cut the dough in two.
Roll out each part on a lightly floured board into a round cake about $1 \mathbf{c m}$ thick.
Cut each cake in 6 parts.
Put them on the baking sheet and brush with milk.
Bake for 10 minutes.
Cool on a wire rack.

Activity 2: To lay a table
Aim:

To learn something about English culture
To make it pleasant at the table during the meal

Procedure:
Choose a group of students to lay the table and make tea while the others are finishing the baking.

Activity 3: To have a nice meal
Aims:

To learn good behaviour during a meal
To learn the right way to express what they want
Useful expressions to know:
I want a glass of water, please.
Would you like a cup of tea?
Yes, please, I'm so thirsty.
Or: No, thank you, I'm not very thirsty.

Activity 4: Different crosswords on the computer Aims:

To learn new words
To encourage cooperation
Procedure:
Pair work. The students work together to find the right words.
