

## **WATER, WATER, FIRE, FIRE**

One of the children is blindfolded and another child hides an object (generally a toy). The blindfolded child starts to look for the object. If the child is far away from the hidden object, the other kids will cry **APA, APA, APA! (WATER, WATER, WATER!)**. If the child starts approaching the object, the other children shout **CALD, CALD, CALD ! (WARM, WARM, WARM!)**. If the blindfolded child is very close to where the toy is hidden, the other kids shout **FOC, FOC, FOC! (FIRE, FIRE, FIRE!)** indicating thus the approximate location of the object. The game continues until the object is found; then another child is blindfolded and searches for the hidden object. The child who has found the object chooses the next child to be blindfolded. Instead of **APA (WATER)** and **FOC (FIRE)**, children may shout **RECE (IT'S COLD)** and **FRIGE (IT'S BURNING)**.
